FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Who is eligible to present at the conclave?

This event is exclusively tailored for students who are presently enrolled in master's or doctoral degree programs in recognized academic institutions to participate as presenters.

Q: What kind of work can I submit?

You are welcome to submit original research work relevant to the various themes outlined in the conclave (please refer to the brochure). However, please note that we do not accept abstracts on research review.

Q: Can I submit a work that has already been published in a journal?

➤ We highly encourage the submission of unpublished ideas and original contributions rather than fully published thesis works. Additionally, we do not accept the work or abstract that have been submitted or presented at any conferences, conventions, symposiums, congresses, or similar events previously.

Q: Is there a specific time frame for the research period?

➤ There is no prescribed time frame for the research period. However, we encourage the submission of recent works, which would be greatly appreciated.

Q: Is there any additional membership charges other than the registration fee?

No, you can avail annual membership by paying a nominal registration fee of Rs.500/-

Q: How can I apply for support grants offered for the students without any fellowship?

➤ If you are selected by the committee and invited to present your work physically in Nagpur, you will be required to submit a signed declaration forwarded by the Head of the Department stating that you haven't been availing any fellowship.

Q: Is there a specific format for abstract submission?

➤ Yes, please refer to the submission guidelines provided in the brochure for specific formatting instructions.

Q: What are the modes of presentation available at the final event at Nagpur?

➤ The conclave offers oral and poster presentations to accommodate diverse research topics. Technical committee will select the abstracts for oral and poster presentation based on the quality of work.

Q: What can I do to apply if my research is ongoing and has not yet been completed?

As we are exclusively accepting original research work, you may submit the research in which you have been actively involved in or have provided assistance, albeit as a second author. We encourage you to provide comprehensive details about your contribution within the submission to ensure appropriate recognition. Even if it's the ongoing work, he or she may present the work that has been completed till now.

Q: Should I submit my poster or PowerPoint presentation herewith?

No, we kindly request that you refrain from submitting your poster or PowerPoint presentation at this stage of the preliminary process. We will provide specific guidelines for the submission of materials in due course after the initial screening of the submitted abstracts.
