Biological invasion is a serious threat to the ecology, biodiversity, and the security of human livelihoods. Fall Armyworm (FAW), *Spodoptera frugiperda* (J.E. Smith) (Lepidoptera: Noctuidae), invaded India during 2018 and devastated the Maize and other cereal crops. FAW's invasion in Asia is a great concern given that the region contributes approximately 30% of global maize supplies, which are now at risk.
